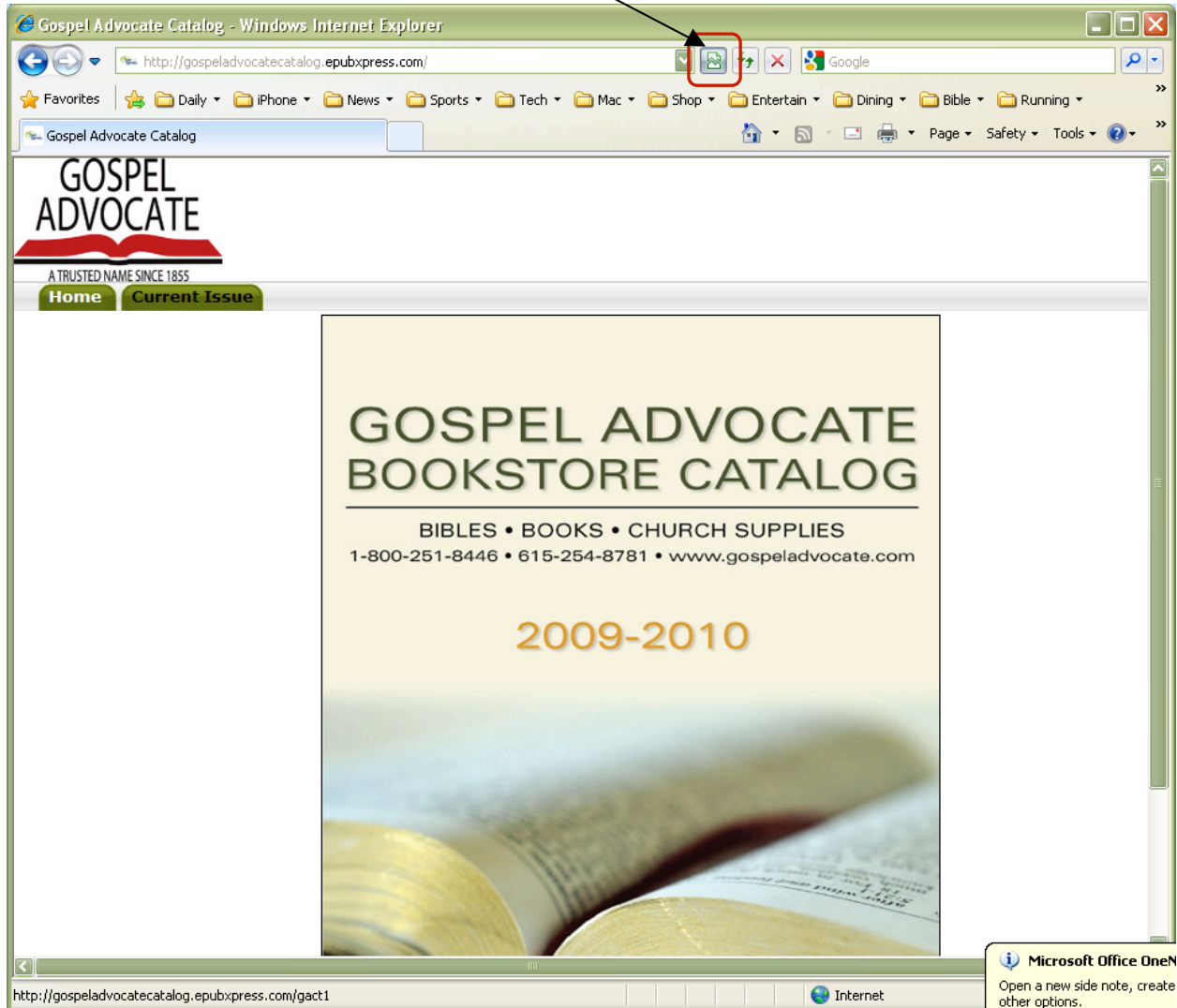


Using the Gospel Advocate On-Line Catalog with Internet Explorer 7 or 8, Firefox or Safari

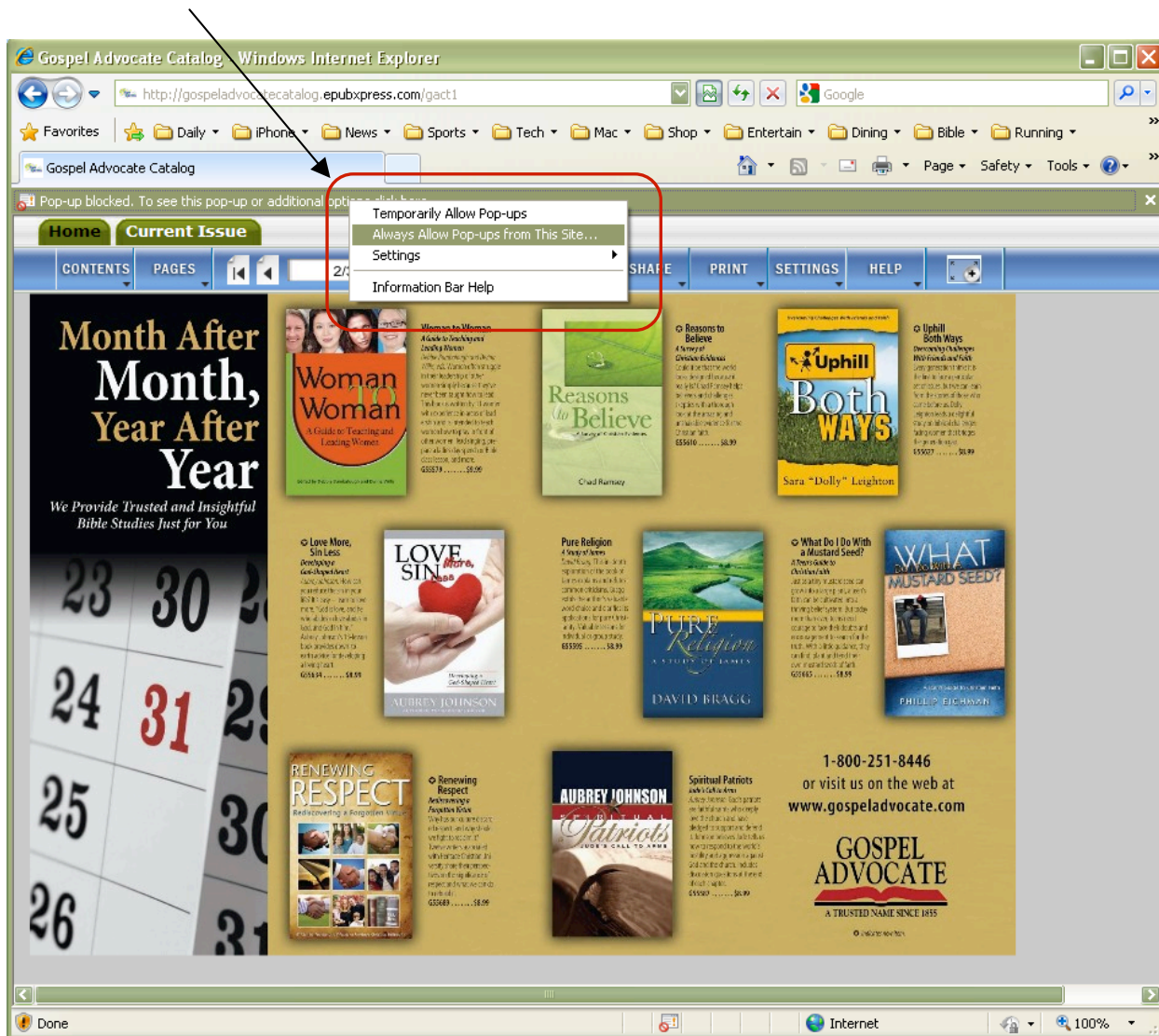
Compatibility Mode (IE Version 8)

In order to use the new Gospel Advocate On-Line catalog with Internet Explorer 8, users must enable the "Compatibility Mode" feature of the browser. This is done by clicking on the "broken page" icon just to the right of the address bar as pictured below:



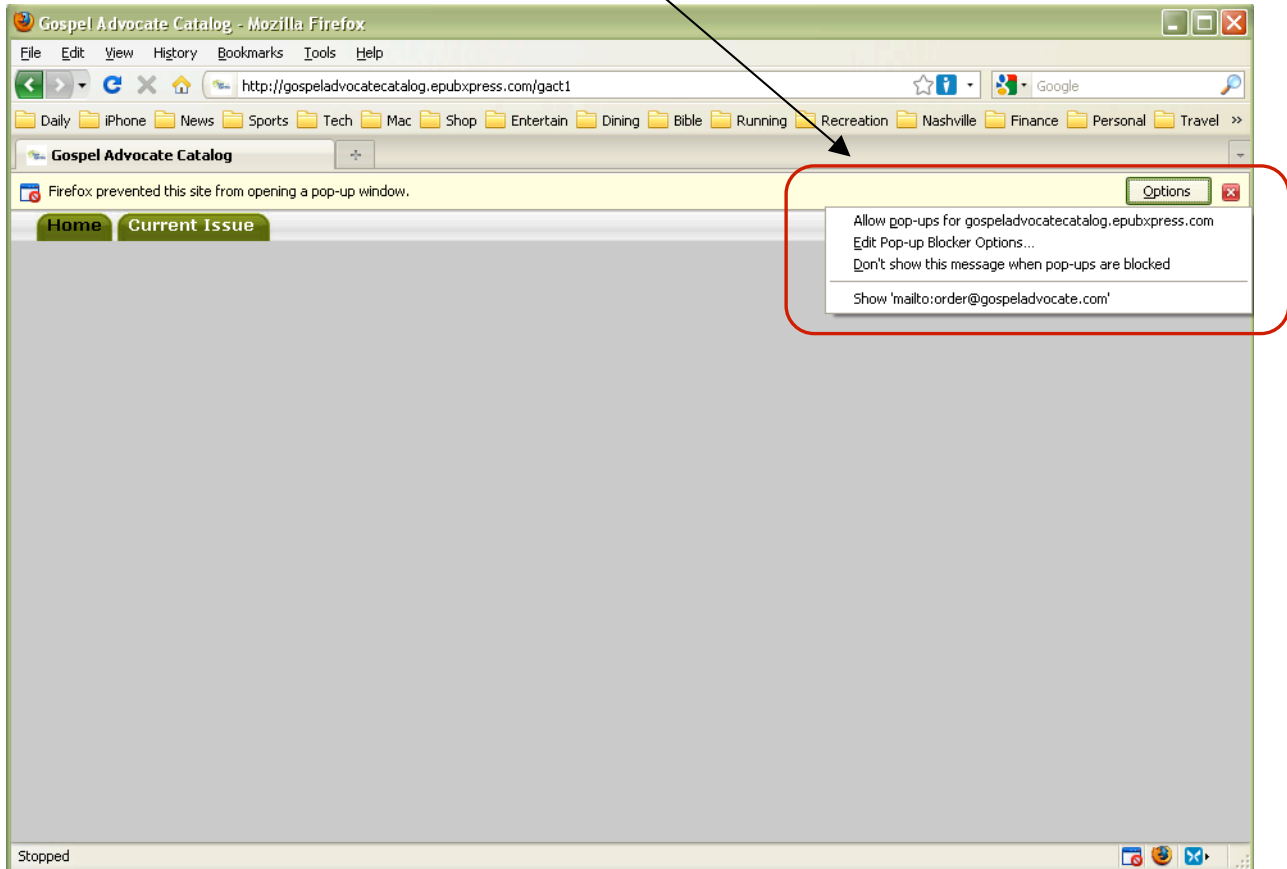
Pop-Up Blocker (IE Version 7 or 8)

When a user clicks on a product link within the new Gospel Advocate Online catalog using either Internet Explorer 7 or 8, a "pop-up blocked" message may appear. In order to display the link, the user should click on the "pop-up blocked" message, and select "Always Allow Pop-ups from This Site..." as pictured below:



Pop-Up Blocker (Firefox Version 3 or above)

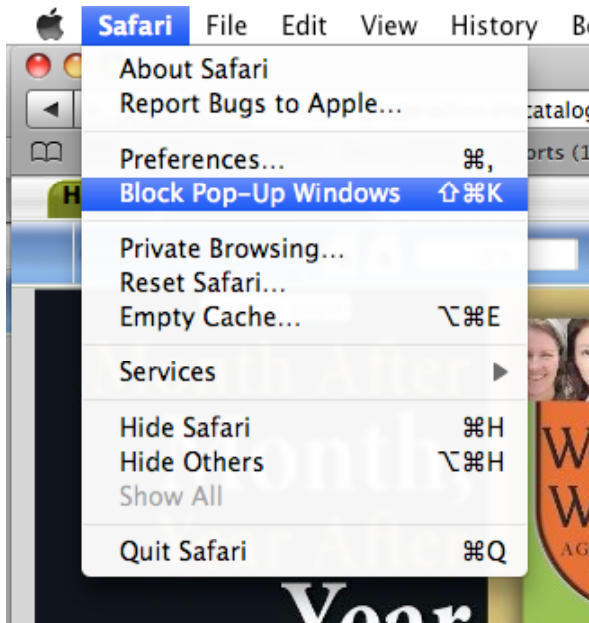
When a user clicks on a product link within the new Gospel Advocate Online catalog using Firefox a “Firefox prevented this site from opening a pop-up window” message may appear. In order to display the link, the user should click on the “options” button, and select “Allow pop-ups for gospeladvocatecatalog.epubxpress.com” as pictured below:



Pop-Up Blocker (Safari for Mac or Windows)

When a user clicks on a product link within the new Gospel Advocate Online catalog using Safari, the item will not display unless the built-in pop-up blocker has been disabled. To do this, click on either the "Safari" menu (Mac Version) in the upper left-hand portion of the screen, or on the gear icon (Windows Version) in the upper right-hand portion of the screen. When the menu is displayed, the user should click on the item labeled "Block Pop-Up Windows," and make sure it is unchecked as pictured below:
